Explore Adobe Creative Cloud Express, an app that allows everyone to create beautiful graphics, web stories, slideshows, and video as well as safe, responsibly sourced generative AI art. Bring a laptop to join in; Adobe Express license recommended but not required. Consult with instructional technology specialists on integrating Adobe Creative Cloud applications into your courses to promote students' digital and AI literacy, applicable in any area of study. Come away from this session with an assignment incorporating multimodal learning ready to implement in your course, increasing student engagement and digital creation skills. 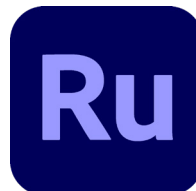
